Designation Guidelines

When you choose to give directly to a specific agency or another United Way, the following procedures apply:

- A minimum amount of \$100 is required for each separate agency designated. You may designate as many agencies as you wish, but each must be a 501c3 charitable organization.
- In the event a designation received is less than the \$100 minimum, the funds will be distributed through the Community Impact Fund.
- Designations to United Way member agencies will be paid separately from their United Way allocation.
- A 6% fee for administration will be deducted on those designations to a 501c3 organization.
- Funds will be forwarded to agency(s) based on compliance with the USA PATRIOT ACT.
- There are no fees for gifts made to the Community Impact Fund, Community Basics, Education, Health & Well-Being, Financial Stability and Safety Net Funds. United Way of Champaign County does not provide fiscal or program oversight for funds designated to a specific agency, nor can it certify the financial or program viability of agencies for those programs not reviewed by our volunteer committees.

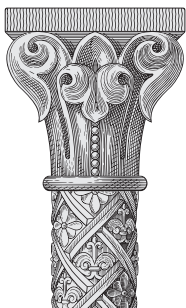
